### Background Information:

Delegates Vanessa Atterbeary and Jen Terrasa work together with their Scholarship Committee to administer their House of Delegates Scholarship program, which is open to residents of Legislative District 13. Maryland law requires that scholarship recipients attend a Maryland college, university or technical or career school. If students are planning to attend an out-of-state school, to be eligible for our scholarship, they must enroll in an academic program that is not offered in Maryland.
